INTRO: Strum one verse as instrumental with riff solo(see below)

1 bar of Calypso strum each chord: C-G-C-G-Am-G-F-G

VERSE 1: **(SN=G)**

IF (C) I could make you (G) mine.

(C) We could spend some (G) time.

(Am) Maybe you could (G) come around on the (F) weekend (G)

(C) Summer's rolling (G) by.

(C) We don't have much (G) time.

(Am) Tell me all a- (G) bout what keeps you (F) ticking (G)

CHORUS:

(Am) We could sit in the sun (Em7/ G6)

Let the (Am) days all roll into (Em7/ G6) one.

How could you (F) take so long to de-(G) cide

How would you (F) know until you (G) tried.

VERSE 2:

(C) Say what's on your (G) mind

(C) Don't be so un (G) kind.

If (Am) you believe in (G) stupid things, like (F) love (G)

CHORUS:
